


Snowmobiling in Voyageurs National Park

The frozen lake surfaces of Rainy, Kabetogama, Namakan, Sand Point, Mukooda and Little Trout lakes, and the Locator Chain of Lakes are open to snowmobile travel. **Snowmobiling is not allowed on the land surface** with the exception of the marked and groomed safety portage trails and the Chain of Lakes scenic trail.

Obey speed limits - 25 mph on safety portages and 45 mph on trails. Staked and groomed trails on the lake surfaces are checked for ice depth. Ice ridges are marked with two orange caution stakes. Use caution when traveling off groomed trails. **Watch for stush and ice pressure ridges.** Obey signs on the lake surface that may indicate areas posted as closed for public safety, wildlife, or other management reasons.


